Subject: **ASSAULTS INVESTIGATION**

On Sunday, January 23, 2022 at approximately 8:20 p.m., Miami Police Officers responded to 911 calls of an apparent verbal argument, followed by gunfire heard at an apartment building located at 201 S.E. 2 Avenue.

Upon police arrival, an extensive canvass was conducted in an effort to locate any possible subject(s) and/or victim(s) who may have been involved. Further investigation revealed no evidence of apparent victim(s) and/or injuries inside of the apartment unit.

Police need the community's assistance in identifying the woman who can be seen exiting the property to determine her involvement and well-being.

**Person of Interest** – Female. Last seen wearing a pink hat, light pink colored sweater, white sneakers. She can be seen carrying a blue handbag while pulling a small white luggage.
