Subject: **2023 ULTRA MUSIC FESTIVAL**

The Ultra Music Festival will take place the weekend of Friday, March 24, 2023, Saturday, March 25, 2023, and Sunday, March 26, 2023, at Bayfront Park in Downtown Miami.

**Friday, March 24, 2023**

Gates open at 4:00 PM until 12:00 AM.

**Saturday, March 25, 2023**

Gates open at 12:00 PM until 12:00 AM.

**Sunday, March 26, 2023**

Gates open at 12:00 PM until 10:00 PM.

**Beginning at 9:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 23, 2023**, all Biscayne Boulevard northbound traffic will be re-routed to the southbound lanes at S.E. 1 Street and returning to the normal trajectory at N.E. 4 Street. All Biscayne Boulevard southbound traffic will be re-routed westbound at N.E. 6 Street. There will be no southbound traffic on Biscayne Boulevard from N.E. 6 Street. All southbound traffic will be detoured to N.E. 2 Avenue and North Miami Avenue.

Miami Police officers will be assigned throughout the area, to assist with residents, patrons, and traffic control. Access to the Port of Miami Traffic will always remain open on NE 5 Street. However, as a recommendation please utilize the Port of Miami Tunnel, which can be accessed from I-395.
