Subject: AUTO SALES BURGLARY

Detectives are investigating a burglary that occurred at J & J Auto Group located at 3445 N.W. 27th Avenue, on February 24th, 2019, at approximately 12:20 a.m.

According to detectives, on February 24th, 2019 at approximately 12:20 a.m. the business owner was contacted by a neighbor who witnessed the suspect entering the business. The victim responded to the scene and reviewed surveillance video. On the video, the suspect is seen inside the business looking under the hoods of vehicles and removing the car batteries. The suspect fled the scene with 4 car batteries valued at over \$500 and also broke the lock of a utility closet.

After exhausting all leads, Burglary Detectives need your assistance in identifying the suspect as the investigation into this burglary continues.

Suspect: tanned male, 40 to 60 years old, white full beard, last seen wearing dark clothing and white sneakers.
