Subject: **THEFT OF A TRAILER**

Detectives are investigating a burglary that occurred at 1910 N.W. 17th Avenue, on April 15th, 2019, at approximately 2:55 a.m.

According to detectives, on April 13, 2019 at approximately 5:00 p.m. the business owner locked the front gate and left. The victim returned to his business on April 15, 2019 at approximately 6:30 a.m. and noticed that the chain and lock to the front gate was cut. The victim reviewed surveillance video and saw the suspects entered the yard and drove off with the victim's 2018 IRDO black trailer which had the words IRON DOG engraved in yellow.

After exhausting all leads, Burglary Detectives need your assistance in identifying the suspects as the investigation into this burglary continues.

Suspect #1: white male, in his 30's, last seen wearing a black t-shirt and long black pants.

Suspect #2: white male, in his 30's, last seen wearing a black sweater, white t-shirt, and long beige pants.

Suspect #3: (look-out) white male, last seen wearing a white shirt, white hat, and unknown colored shorts.

Vehicle: early 2000 two-toned (burgundy over gold) Chevrolet Silverado crew cab.
