Subject: RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY

Miami Police are investigating a residential burglary which took place on October 28, 2021., from a home located at 815 N.E. 82 Street.

According to detectives, the homeowner who was out of town received a phone call from her contractor who notified her of an apparent burglary due to damages to her front window. Upon the victims' return home on November 1, 2021, she reported to police that her home had been burglarized and miscellaneous items including electronics and tools had been stolen.

Video surveillance depicts an unknown subject on the victims' property.

Suspect: Male, approximately 30-35 years of age. Last seen wearing what appears to be a black shirt with a white tank top over it.
