Subject: **FATAL SHOOTING INVESTIGATION**

Today, at approximately 1:03 p.m., Miami Police responded to 2082 N.W. 24 Street reference shots fired in the area.

According to investigators, once officers arrived on scene, they located a black male who appeared to have been suffering from apparent gunshot wound(s).

Miami Fire Rescue responded on scene and immediately transported the wounded victim to Jackson Memorial Hospital where he succumbed to his injuries.

Detectives are investigating leads and possible motive(s) and ask that anyone with information on this incident to please contact the Miami Police Department and/or Crime Stoppers.

Detectives are withholding the victim's identity until next of kin notifications are completed.

The investigation continues.
