Subject: 2019 Escape to Miami Triathlon



Escape to Miami Triathlon 2019

The Escape to Miami Triathlon will take place on **Sunday, September 22, 2019** and will start at Pace Island and finish at Margaret Pace Park.

- This event is scheduled to take place from 6 a.m. until 1p.m.

This Olympic and Sprint distance triathlon will start at Pace Island, with a swim to Margaret Pace Park.

The competitors will then mount their bicycles and travel west on N.E. 18th Street to N.E. 2nd Avenue, turn right and go north on N.E. 2nd Avenue to N.E. 36th Street.

They will continue east on N.E. 36th Street into Miami Beach via the Julia Tuttle Causeway. The bike course returns from Miami Beach west on the Julia Tuttle Causeway and exits at Biscayne Boulevard, back to Federal Highway.

The course turns north to N.E. 47th Street and turns around back south on the same course, back into the park.

The run portion of the triathlon begins at Margaret Pace Park, after the completion of the bike course. The run course starts southbound on N. Bayshore Drive to N.E. 13th Street and goes east on the MacArthur Causeway.

The athletes will turn around at Star Island for a return to the finish line via the same course and finish at Margaret Pace Park. The estimated attendance is approximately 2,000 participants.
