PARK RANGER GRADUATION CEREMONY

The City of Miami Police Department is proud to announce the upcoming graduation of 26 City of Miami Park Rangers who have successfully completed an intensive Park Ranger Development Training Program. This initiative was spearheaded by Parks Supervisor Rafael Amato, Dr. Richard Holton and Major Albert Guerra of the Training and Development Section. The training encompassed 72 hours of rigorous classroom instruction and hands-on exercises designed to strengthen public safety and enforcement across Miami's parks.

This training marks the first in a series of professional development initiatives for Park Rangers, with a primary focus on equipping them with advanced skills essential for community engagement, rule enforcement, and emergency response. The curriculum included CPR and emergency medical aid, defensive tactics for personal and public safety, traffic control for civilian protection, and situational awareness to help identify and respond to potential threats. These capabilities are vital to the Park Rangers' mission of maintaining safe, welcoming public spaces for all residents and visitors.

Upon graduation, the Rangers will return to their posts with enhanced readiness and a renewed commitment to service. They will continue to work in close coordination with the Miami Police Department, ensuring seamless communication and unified support across the city's parks and recreational areas.
