Subject: OFFICER INJURED AS WOMAN ATTEMPTS TO ELUDE POLICE



Today at 2:28 AM, Miami Police officers attempted to perform a routine traffic stop on a gold Nissan Maxima. The officers learned through a computer check that the vehicle appeared to have been stolen from the Miami Gardens area. The driver attempted to flee, but officers followed it to the intersection of Northwest 7th Avenue and Northwest 23 Street where the driver lost control. Officers strategically placed their marked police units around the vehicle and ordered the driver to exit the vehicle. Woodward, the driver refused and put the vehicle into reverse. Officer George A. Guillen, a two year member of the Miami Police Department exited his marked police vehicle and was pinned against his cruiser. Once more the driver attempted to flee and hit another police vehicle. Woodward than fled on foot, but officers were able to take her into custody.

Then the officer was transported to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Unit and treated for minor injuries.

Both, the driver and passenger were arrested. (See attached Arrest Affidavit)

Charges: Attempted first degree Murder on a law enforcement officer, fleeing and eluding police, resisting arrest without violence, possession of cocaine, and possession of drug paraphernalia

Passenger: Alfred Leroy Robinson, D.O.B. - 10/24/1970 of 520 Eucid Avenue #1, Miami Beach Florida.

Charges: trespass in a conveyance, resisting arrest without violence.
