Subject: ONE SHOT KILLS WOMAN, UNKNOWN MOTIVE

On Monday, January 11, 2010, members of the Miami-Dade County Police Department's Robbery Intervention Detail recovered the unoccupied white Mazda in the vicinity of Northwest 24th Avenue and 58th Street.

Detectives continue to look for the driver of the vehicle who is known on the street as "Yella-Boy" along with an accomplice which is described as a black male, 20-30 years old known on the street as "Rod".

Today, The Miami Police Department's Homicide Unit Detectives were able to arrest Wesley Bernard Henton, D.O.B. 3/24/1982 and charge him with one count of First Degree Murder, one count of Use Of A Firearm In The Commission Of A Felony and one count of Armed Robbery (See attached Arrest Affidavit).

An anonymous tipster led Miami Police Detectives to Henton. The Miami Police Department's Homicide Unit was assisted by members of The Miami Police Department's Robbery Unit, City of Miami Gardens Police Department and Miami-Dade County Police Department.

Members of City of Miami Gardens Police Department arrested and charged Henton for an Armed Robbery he committed within their jurisdiction.

Homicide Detectives continue to look for the white four door Mazda and the driver, which is described as a light skin black male with long dreads in his mid twenties, approximately 5'11" tall and weighs 195 lbs. He is known on the street as "yellow man or yellow boy".
