The Race for the Cure will take place on Saturday, October 17, 2009.

- The race will start at 8:30am in front of Bayfront Park.
- 15,000 runners/walkers expected to participate.
- Streets closures will commence at 6:30 AM.
- The streets shall reopen by 10:30am.
- Race promoter John Hans Huseby from Team Foot Works.

RACE COURSE

- The race will start at Biscayne Boulevard and NE 1st Street, proceed North to NE 4th Street, West on NE 4th St to NE 1st Avenue, South on NE 1st Ave to NE 3rd Street, East on 3rd St to 2nd Ave, South on 2nd Ave to SE 14th terrace where the participants will turn around heading North on Brickell Ave then East on Biscayne Blvd Way finishing at Bayfront Park.

Detours:

If you travel North on Brickell Ave, at SE 15 Road you will be re-routed East to Brickell Key Drive or West to Miami Ave.

Traffic exiting Brickell Key or the many buildings along Brickell Key Drive will be assisted out at SE 15 Road. Residents who live on Brickell Key will gain access thru SE 15 Road.

A counter flow will be established on Biscayne Blvd from NE 5 St to SE 2 St. Access to the Miami Center and the Intercontinental Hotel will be allowed on SE 1 St.

Miami Police officers will be deployed along the route to assist motorists.
