In addition to the traffic closures and re-routes, Maurice Ferre Park, 1075 Biscayne Blvd. will be shut down from **6 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.**

On October 15, 2020, the 45th President of the United States, Donald J. Trump (POTUS) will be visiting the Miami area and traffic delays are expected.

In conjunction with the Miami Beach Police Department, the Macarthur Causeway (I-395) will be completely shut down in the eastbound and westbound directions for vehicular, pedestrians and cyclists. The closure will begin at 7pm until approximately 11pm, and times are subject to change.

We encourage you use the Julia Tuttle Causeway (I-195) or the 79th Street Causeway to enter or exit the City of Miami Beach. Residents of Palm, Hibiscus, Star and Fisher Islands may return home via the westbound Macarthur Causeway. All other traffic must exit the City of Miami Beach via the alternate causeways. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
