Subject: TODDLER SHOT INSIDE OF HIS HOME



On today, August 4, 2015 at approximately 6:10 A.M., the City of Miami Police were contacted by Miami Dade County Police via Jackson Memorial Hospital, stating that there was a toddler, approximately three (3) years of age that had been shot. Miami Police Officers arrived at Jackson Memorial Hospital's Trauma Center, and verified that there was a toddler that had been shot that was transported there in a private vehicle from 112 Northeast 71st Street.

Officers responded to the 112 Northeast 71st Street, which is the home of the victim. They found evidence at that location that someone had been shot inside of the home. The victim is in critical condition.

The investigation continues.
